

## Minutes from September 22, 2020

### Parish Pastoral Council Meeting

- I. Opening Prayer led by Deacon John
- II. Minutes from February Approved
- III. Parish Finances:
  - Parish revenue has dropped considerably due to the Coronavirus pandemic. Collections are down \$10,000 to \$15,000 and the loss from gym rentals is considerable.
  - Fiscal year ended with a loss of \$2,500. Three events helped with keeping the loss to a minimum.
    1. Trivia Night from October 2019, raised \$10,000
    2. Holy Redeemer donated 1/3 of the profits from their Auction Fund Raiser, \$20,500
    3. PPE Small Business Loan for \$28,700-this loan should be forgiven-being used for payroll and utilities
- IV. Updates from Deacon John:
  - Roof on west side of church has been repaired. Working on plans to repairs roof on east side.
  - Ann Hannon is close to having the updated parish web site completed.
  - Elections need to be held for the Parish Pastoral Council. Deacon John will address from the pulpit and a notice will be placed in the bulletin requesting volunteers and or nominees.
- V. Pastoral Statement on Racism:
  - The Parish Pastoral Council will begin creating a statement against racism. The council will reach out to parishioners letting them know process is beginning and requesting their input.
  - By getting individual parishes involved, the Catholic Church can/should become more active and vocal in the social justice movement. This movement is not political, it is a racism issue.
